Following graduation, he studied Commerce at The University of Melbourne and subsequently went on to merchant banking before taking up at The Shann Group as Director / Shareholder. This appointment coincided with a number of public company directorships.

Les continues to enjoy sport running distances up to marathons, golfing and tennis.

- Previous recipients are not eligible to apply in subsequent years.
