THE PARIS & PAULA KRITHARIDES SCHOLARSHIP

- The Paris & Paula Kritharides Scholarship consists of a payment of \$1,000 and is accompanied by a certificate with citation.
- One scholarship is awarded each year.
- The scholarship is awarded following receipt of written applications and interviews of shortlisted applicants.
- Previous recipients are not eligible to apply in subsequent years.

CRITERIA

Applicants should:

- a. be a current Year 10 or Year 11 student at Melbourne High School;
- b. demonstrate outstanding service to family, the School and broader community;
- c. have excellent academic results;
- d. demonstrate how the scholarship would assist in lessening financial hardship

Consideration will also be given to applicants who can demonstrate their involvement in the broader aspects of Melbourne High School life.
