

## THE RONALD DODGE SCHOLARSHIP

**The Ronald Dodge Scholarship is awarded annually to one MHS Year 11 student undertaking STEM-related subjects in support of his VCE studies.**



### ABOUT RONALD DODGE

After graduating from Melbourne High School, Ron Dodge (MHS 1965) completed a Bachelor of Industrial Engineering at The University of Melbourne.

Joining Airport Luggage in 1970, his early focus was on moving manufacturing offshore. Ron was instrumental in forming a joint venture between Samsonite and Airport Luggage, where he became the Chairman of Samsonite Australia for 9 years.

He also co-founded Spartan School Supplies, Australia's leading supplier of school bags, accessories and primary school clothing. Ron has always been fascinated with the construction industry. In 1995 he formally started Point Property Group, facilitating the purchase and development of property throughout Australia.

Ron offers this Scholarship in support of students in STEM, recognising the impressive start his studies provided him. Although he did not enter a STEM related field, the skills he acquired have guided his decision making in every aspect of his life.

## THE RONALD DODGE SCHOLARSHIP

- The Ronald Dodge Scholarship consists of a payment of \$2,500
- The Award is accompanied by a certificate with citation
- One Scholarship is awarded each year
- The Scholarship is awarded following receipt of written applications and interviews of shortlisted applicants
- Previous recipients are not eligible to apply in subsequent years.

## CRITERIA

Applicants should:

- a. be a current Year 11 student at Melbourne High School;
- b. demonstrate STEM-related subjects being undertaken with a view to completing STEM-related subjects in VCE
- c. demonstrate excellent academic results;
- d. demonstrate how the scholarship would particularly support STEM-related coaching or extra-curricular activities as part of VCE studies

Consideration will also be given to applicants who can demonstrate financial hardship.
