- Previous recipients are not eligible to apply.

CRITERIA

Applicants to the David Loh Family Scholarship should:

- a) be a current Melbourne High School student in Year 11 or Year 12;
- b) demonstrate excellent academic results; and
- c) demonstrate leadership within the MHS and/or broader community.
